

Day 1 - Arrival in Rome

EVENING

Arrival and check-in at 4* Hotel in the Heart of Rome's business district
Free time to relax
Free dinner

Day 2 - Ancient Rome

MORNING

Following breakfast at the hotel, meet-up at reception with english speaking tour guide for an evocative tour of Ancient Rome, from the **Imperial Forums** and the **Coliseum**, through some of the most famous hills of the city, notably known as historic shelters from floodings and enemies.

Lunch at a typical local restaurant

AFTERNOON

Following lunch, the tour will continue through Piazza Venezia and Piazza Esedra all the way to the famous Via Vittorio Veneto (one of the most famous and expensive streets in Rome). From there you will continue on to Porta Pinciana and visit Villa Borghese for a panoramic tour.

Day 3 - Vatican Museums & Roman Squares

MORNING

Following breakfast at the Hotel, meet-up at reception with spanish speaking guide and and transfer by private coach to the Vatican Museums.

Upon arrival. view of the modern entrance built for the Millennium Jubilee, and visit of the Galleries of the Chandeliers, the Tapestries and the Geographical Maps, the Sobiesky Hall and the Immaculate Conception Hall, leading on to the Sistine Chapel, seat of the Conclave, with the famous frescoes of Michelangelo.

Passing inside the Vatican Museums we will arrive into the **Basilica of Saint Peter**, commonly called Saint Peter's Basilica, is one of four major basilicas of Rome.

From the Basilica of St Peter's, transfer to **Castel St'Angelo**, for an exterior visit of the building.

Lunch at a typical local restaurant.

AFTERNOON

Following lunch the tour will continue through the baroque square of **Piazza Navona**, known today as the square of the artists and the "Four Rivers Fountain", following on to the **Pantheon**, a real architectural wonder of Ancient Rome and today, burial place of notable writers, artists, architects and Italian Kings.

The tour will end at the **Trevi Fountain**, a Baroque masterpiece created by Nicola Salvi and known as being the largest fountain in the city.

Return transfer to Hotel and free time to relax.

Day 4 - Turin & The Holy Shroud

MORNING

Arrival in Turin and Check-in at 4* Hotel in Turin City Center Free time to relax
Free lunch

AFTERNOON

Following lunch, meeting with official english speaking guide for a 3 hour guided tour of the city and of its main highlights, followed by a visit to the **Holy Shroud Museum**.

Return to Hotel and free time to relax and change Dinner at a typical Local restaurant Return by foot to Hotel

Day 5- Val Susa, Portacomaro, Turin

MORNING

Following breakfast at the Hotel, meet up with english speaking guide and transfer by private coach to the Susa Valley for a delightful morning excursion.

On the way, stopover in Buttigliera Alta for a visit to the **Abbey of Sant'Antonio di Ranverso.**

Transfer to Avigliana for a visit of the **Sacra di San Michele**, Return transfer to Turin with stopover on the way for lunch at a typical local restaurant

AFTERNOON

Following lunch, transfer to Portacomaro a small town near Asti, know as the land of origin of the family of our newly elected Pope Francesco.

Visit of the town and the Parish Church of Portacomaro followed by transfer to the Cathedral of Asti, located only 8km from Portacomaro.

Return transfer to Turin and free time to relax. Free dinner

Day 6 - Superga & Venaria



MORNING

Breakfast at Hotel followed by transfer by coach to **Superga** for a visit of the Royal Tombs at the **Basilica di Superga** and a spectacular view of Torino City and the surrounding mountains.

Transfer to Venaria for guided visit of **Venaria Palace & Gardens**, also known as Piedmont's Versailles.

Lunch at a typical local restaurant

AFTERNOON

Return to Turin and drop off at Hotel. Free time available Farewell dinner at a typical local restaurant
